About QU Health Interprofessional Education Program

The IPE Committee (IPEC) was founded in 2014 by Qatar University College of Pharmacy to provide guidance and support in implementing IPE within the pharmacy curriculum, as well as in our partner healthcare training programs in the country. It was moved to QU Health level in 2017 which was established to jointly design, implement and evaluate IPE initiatives at QU Health working alongside other healthcare programs in Qatar.

The committee oversees the integration of interprofessional education within all the curricula at QU Health and to promote awareness for IPE and interprofessional collaboration in Qatar and the Middle East. The Committee members include representatives from around twenty programs at four institutions:

- QU: College of Pharmacy, College of Medicine, College of Dental Medicine, College of Nursing and College of Health Sciences which has four departments: Biomedical Sciences, Public Health, Human Nutrition, and Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation
- Weill Cornell Medicine – Qatar (WCMC-Q);
- University of Calgary – Qatar (UC-Q) nursing school and;
- University of Doha for Science and Technology

Interprofessional Education Passport Program was launched in Fall 2021 to offer structured integration and assessment of IPE in the different health programs. Students must complete a minimum of four IPE activities and submit a reflective assignment as per their assigned course/ module. Ultimately, a certificate of IPE passport program completion will be obtained after the student fulfills the program's requirement signed by the Vice President for Health and Medical Sciences.
